At various times throughout the year Three Lions Stage offers customized public workshops on theatrical and entertainment industry standards and trends. Some workshops include panel discussions with industry professionals, agents, managers, directors, producers, and performers and may include audition evaluations.

Innovative in its approach Three Lions Stage is creating new and existing literary theatrical works, and helping to reshape how creative artists and audiences alike experience themselves through the collective human continuum. Firm in this commitment, Three Lions Stage exists to enrich the lives of professional creative artists and audiences everywhere, through the exploration and use of non-traditional casting methods. Diversity is central to our organization's overall mission thereby creating professional

Achievement of our mission takes form in various activities and programs, among them, Theatrical Staged Readings, Experimental Labs, Developmental Workshops, Showcase and Stage Productions, Community Outreach and Audience Education, and our Creative Learning Programs.

THEATRICAL PROGRAMS

Through our innovative **Roaring Reading Series** TLS works with emerging playwrights in the development of new artistic works. Playwrights have an opportunity to work with some of the best theater Actors and Directors in New York over the course of several weeks and see their work presented, some for the very first time before a live audience. The Roaring Reading Series is an exciting opportunity to see new works in development as they are presented with minimal staging using scripts in hand.



Experimental Labs foster creativity, freedom of discovery, and development of new ideas and techniques to a theatrical work, be it from a dramatic, musical, or technical aspect by creating synergies of expression among artists. This approach fuels the creative process that can often

lead to a ground breaking technique or new theatrical work.



Developmental Workshops are a natural progression in creating a working template from which to apply artistic vision, and often involves casting actors, dancers, musicians and technical artists of all kinds. Workshops are often presented to select audiences to elicit reactions, discussion, and consideration of financial backing for a possible professional production.

Showcases are staged productions that are presented before live audiences at considerably reduced ticket prices. They hold high artistic value and are exciting opportunities to present established and emerging artists, playwrights, directors and in some cases new theatrical works.
